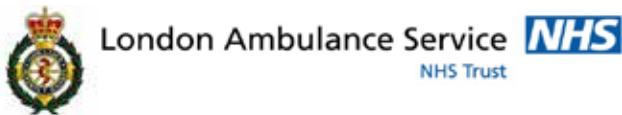

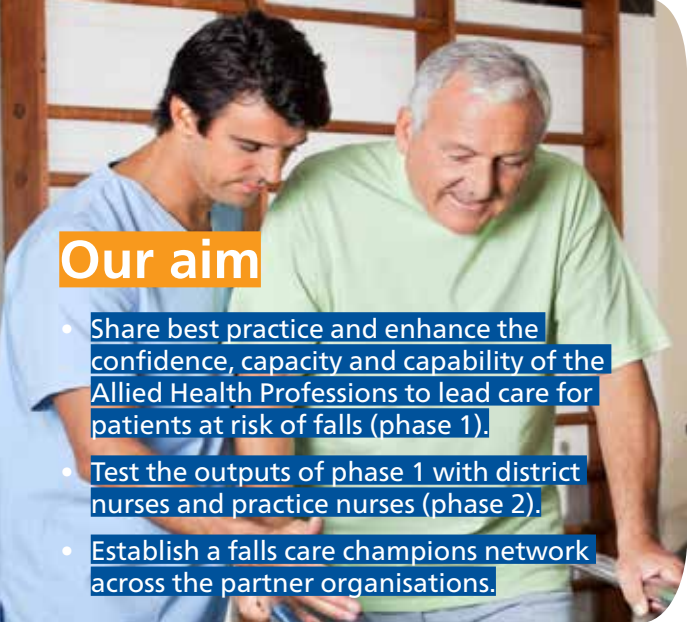

Our aim

- Share best practice and enhance the confidence, capacity and capability of the Allied Health Professions to lead care for patients at risk of falls (phase 1).
- Test the outputs of phase 1 with district nurses and practice nurses (phase 2).
- Establish a falls care champions network across the partner organisations.

Which professions is ALIGN aimed at?

- ALIGN will initially be aimed at Allied Health Professionals (AHPs) and the associated unregistered workforce working with AHPs in the first phase.
- Following this first phase practice nurses and district nurses will be included in the network.

What will be the outcomes of ALIGN?

- Scope current practice in falls management across the network and identify current learning and development opportunities.
- Promote and facilitate shared learning and best practice across non-medical professionals about falls management, integrated prevention and support in falls care.
- Enable best practice in falls management to be shared within and out with HENWL.
- Enable communication and networking between Allied Health Professionals, practice nurses and district nurses in falls management.

How will we achieve these outcomes?

- Through an education innovation model involving the:
 - Development and delivery of action learning sessions.
 - Development of an online learning platform.
 - Development of innovation champions in falls care.
 - Development of a learning circle to promote innovation in falls care.
- Identify how service users' experience can inform the proactive management of falls.
- Identify how simulation can be used in the prevention and management of falls through the simulation suite at Buckinghamshire New University.



How will we make ALIGN sustainable?

Through the establishment of:

- an online digital learning community.
- a falls care champions network to enable collaboration, partnership working, adoption and spread of good practice in falls management within and out with the area covered by HENWL to the wider multidisciplinary workforce.
